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Learning Focus

The **Lead the Way** incursion is designed to show that each student can play a part in influencing their school by a) the choices they make, b) their unique skills and c) how they treat others. We highlight how leadership skills such as taking initiative, communication, being trustworthy and having goals can make a positive difference. Through a variety of **interactive activities, games, discussion, stories, multi-media,** and **video** the workshop equips students to extend their own skills and the consider the responsibility they play as a leader in their school and beyond.

The **Lead the Way** incursion is recommended for upper primary but can be tailored to meet the needs of students from lower to mid primary. In addition to the student incursion, a complimentary teacher resource manual & curriculum is provided that can be implemented & modified to extend the learning outcomes in the classroom over several weeks.

Key concepts covered in the session:

- ▶ Good leadership better enables us to communicate, work well together and have a great school
- ▶ A good leader is responsible - they consider others and the consequences of their actions
- ▶ Everybody can be a great leader and different people lead in different ways
- ▶ We can all learn and improve our skills in becoming a leader
- ▶ A great leader takes initiative
- ▶ We need to consider the influence we make and how it impacts others
- ▶ We all need good role models, and consequently we need to be a good role model to others
- ▶ Our values determine the decisions we make
